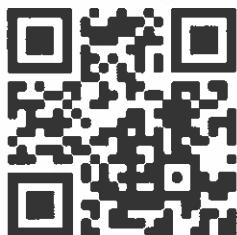

**Ready Set Learn** is a 4-week program that will provide caregivers and their child with a learning experience that will support a successful school start. Each week we offer activities that will help children develop skills and behaviours important to the school transition as well as conversations with our Early Childhood Educator on a variety of learning and development topics. Registration required.



**Bounce Back & Thrive!** (BBT) is a 10-week resiliency skills training program designed to meet the needs of parents and caregivers of children under the age of 8. BBT helps parents gain self-regulation and thinking skills that increase their capacity to provide caring relationships and role model resilience-building skills in daily interactions with their children. Then, it shows parents how to directly introduce basic resiliency skills to children. Registration required.

**Play & Learn** offers a play-based learning opportunity in one of our indoor library program spaces. Activities planned by our EarlyON facilitators encourage positive parent and child interaction and inspire play and learning! We also offer a circle time (songs and stories) at the end of program.

**Open Spaces Outdoor Adventures** are adventures in learning in the great outdoors. We let your child(ren) take the lead in these nature-based programs. Best suited for children 2 to 6 years of age, but children from 0-6 ages welcome. Registration required.

## DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENING SUPPORT

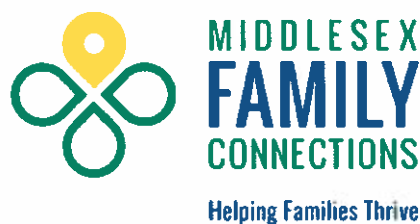


## GETTING A LIBRARY CARD

A library card is free for all residents of Middlesex County. To register for a card, please visit a Middlesex County Library branch during open hours. Please bring with you a piece of photo identification and proof of address (examples include your driver's license or photo health card or passport and a bill in your name or student card and report card). A parent or legal guardian needs to sign the library card registration form for their child up to and including age 13.
